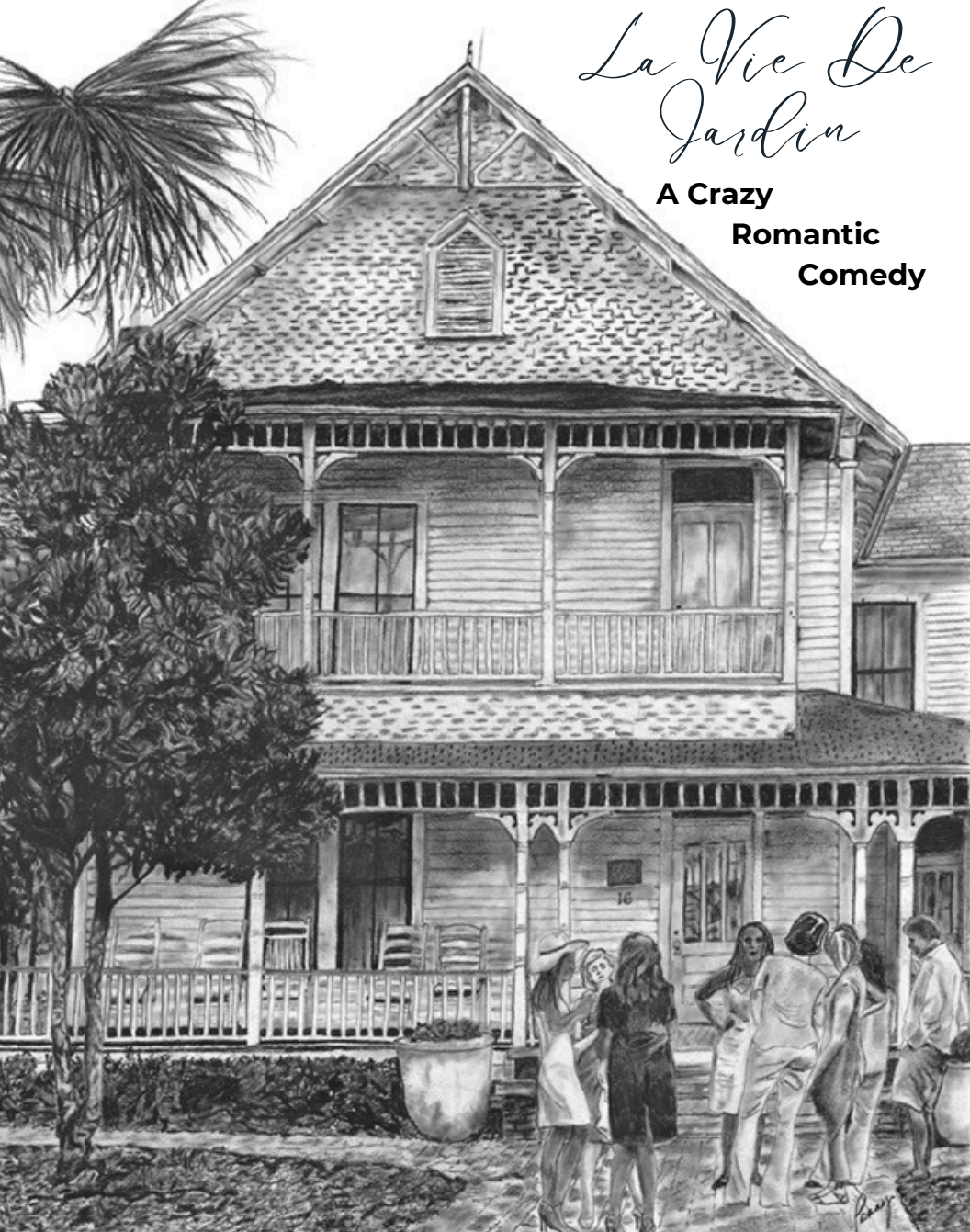

Ivan participated in the City of Winter Garden 2023 Black History Art Exhibition. He has also been exhibited at the lovely Mills Gallery in December 2023.

**Wonda Granville:** Wonda grew up in Oviedo where everyone calls her, “Penny.” She loves creating images, people are captivating...the way they look, smile and move. The faces say it all; People are truly God’s art. She was an Emerging Artist at the Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival in March 2022. Her drawing Mr. Winzo was showcased at Orlando Museum Platform in October 2023. Her art was exhibited at the Terrance Gallery in Orlando City Hall for Black History for 2024.
